The most sick and fragile in society are still valuable because they are made in God's image. But evidence shows that, very quickly, allowing euthanasia puts vulnerable people at risk.

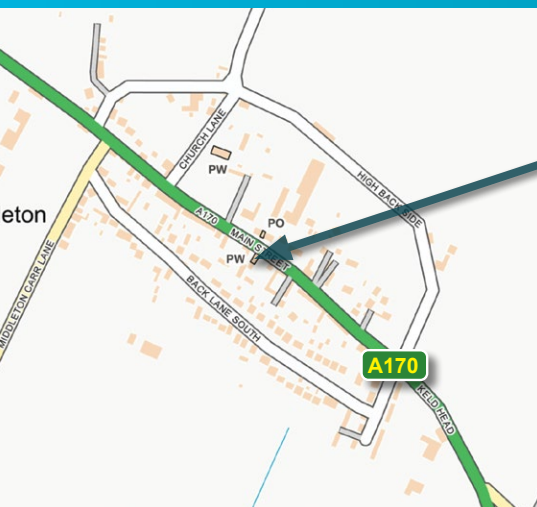
Gambling
